

## Grant Competition Regulation

to participate in the 8<sup>th</sup> International Congress “Energy Fluxes and Radiation Effects” (EFRE 2022) (October 2–8, 2022, Tomsk, Russia) for free.

### 1. Competition appointment

The aim of the Competition is to encourage and stimulate the scientific and creative activity of young scientists, whose subject and orientation of work is similar or intersects with the topics of the Congress.

### 2. Terms and definitions

*Congress* – the 8<sup>th</sup> International Congress “Energy Fluxes and Radiation Effects” (EFRE 2022) which will be held on October 2–8, 2022 in Tomsk, Russia.

*Grant* – gratuitous subsidy provided by the Organizers of the Congress to the winner of the contest to pay the registration fee for the Congress.

*Competition* – grant application.

*Contestant* – a young person (young scientist, graduate student, an undergraduate student) who, in the prescribed manner, has provided the necessary documents for participation in the competition.

*Abstract* – application for the report prepared and submitted in the form specified on the website of the Congress.

*Registration fee* – payment made by conference participants for participation and publication of abstracts and articles. *Committee* – collegial body conducting competitive selection of grant recipients based on the objective advantages of the application.

### 3. Key points

3.1. The competition is held among contestants under the age of 35 (inclusively).

3.2. Applications are accepted until February 13, 2022.

### 4. The order of the competition

4.1. Application for participation in the Competition is submitted in the prescribed form (Appendix 1).

4.2. Collection, initial verification and registration of applications is carried out by the Local Organizing Committee of the Congress.

4.3. Initial verification of the application is carried out according to the criteria:

- meeting deadlines;
- compliance of the application with the requirements for completeness;
- availability of a registered Thesis on the Congress website (automatically added to the database).

4.4. If inconsistencies are found in the application during the initial inspection, the Local Organizing Committee may return the application for revision.

4.5. Applications may be rejected by the Committee from participation in the Competition on the following grounds:

- submitted application does not meet the requirements of the Competition set forth in the Regulation on the grant competition in the nomination;
- application is submitted later than the deadline for their acceptance;
- the applicant is a member of the competitive Committee, a spouse or close relative of a member of the Committee.

4.6. The Committee carries out competitive selection of applicants and, based on the results of voting, approves the final protocol, which indicates:

- composition of participants in the Competition;
- list of winners of the Competition.

4.7. The Committee announces the list of winners of the Competition no later than 20 business days from the date of receipt of applications.

4.8. The results of the Competition are published on the official website of the Congress no later than 5 working days after the approval of the winners of the Competition.

4.9. Contest participants who become winners of the Contest, within 5 working days from the date of the decision, are notified by email.

## **5. Duties of the parties**

5.1. Congress organizers are required to implement:

- payment of the registration fee for the winners of the Competition;
- payment for the publication of two papers in the proceedings of the Congress for the winners of the Competition;

5.2. A winner of the Competition has to:

- submit an oral presentation to the Congress in English (20 min);
- pay for travel, meals and accommodation himself.
